

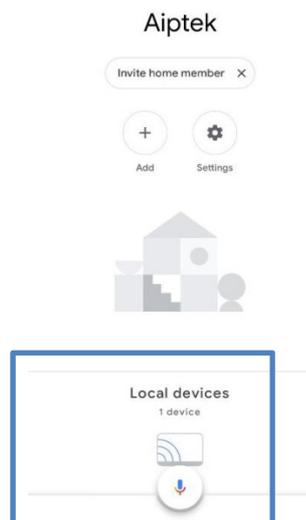
Set up your Chromecast device to work with Aiptek Projector

What you need to get started

- A Chromecast device (Chromecast or Chromecast Ultra)
- An AIPTEK projector
- Latest version of the Google Home app  and install it with a Google account.
- Access to an available power outlet for Chromecast.
- A phone or tablet meets the minimum OS requirements to run the Google Home app 
- An internet connection and access to a secure wireless network (make sure you have the wireless network password handy)

Set up Chromecast or Chromecast Ultra

1. Turn on the Aiptek Projector.
2. Plug in Chromecast on the HDMI port of Aiptek projector and connect the Chromecast to a power outlet or if possible on the USB port of Aiptek projector supporting Power Bank feature.
3. Make sure to connect your mobile device/tablet to the Wi-Fi network (not the Aiptek projector), which you intend to use to set up your Chromecast device.
4. Open the Google Home app .
5. Follow the steps shown on mobile/tablet.
If you **don't see the steps to set up your Chromecast**, on the Google Home app's home screen, tap  to add new devices.
6. When the setup is successful, you will be able to see **'Local devices' - 1 device** such as **'Büro'** on the bottom of home screen of Google Home.



7. Open the App such as 'Netflix' and log in with your account. Play a video. A cast icon appears  in the right top corner. Click this icon to connect to Chromecast. The video will start playing back on Aiptek projector.
8. To stop the casting, click the icon  to disconnect with Chromecast, or click **'Pause'** on Google Home 'Local devices – Büro'.

Set up Amazon Fire TV to work with **Aiptek Projector**

What you need to get started

- An Amazon Fire TV disk, power plug, and remote control
- An Amazon Prime account
- An AIPTEK projector

Set up Amazon Fire TV

1. Turn on the Aiptek Projector.
2. Plug in Amazon Fire TV on the HDMI port of Aiptek projector and connect the Fire TV to a power outlet or if possible on the USB port of Aiptek projector supporting Power Bank feature.
3. The home screen of Amazon Fire TV appears on the projector screen. Enter '**Network**' to connect to local network.
4. Enter '**Settings**' to use your Amazon account to log in.
5. Now you can start watching films.
6. Use remote control from Aiptek projector to adjust the volume.
